



The Monument and the Unveiling

The monument or grave maker can be selected any time after the funeral. Be aware it takes 3-5 months to process a monument order. Traditionally, the unveiling (monument dedication) occurs in the eleventh month of mourning. The ceremony is usually held on a Sunday. The full Hebrew name of the deceased as well as his or her English name should be used. The Hebrew and English dates of birth and death may be included, as well as a short Hebrew descriptive phrase.
